The Empty Tomb Means "Emmanuel" [God With Us]!

Mary Magdalene was filled with distress when she discovered the empty tomb on that first Easter morning. The two disciples who ran to check out the grave site were filled with questions when they saw the folded grave cloth. The other disciples were filled with fear and locked themselves in an apartment fearing repercussions from the mobs. An empty Easter egg is filled with discouragement for the one who finds it. The empty egg is a better symbol for Easter than one filled with treats.

Empty often brings feelings of disappointment, distress, and discouragement, but the empty tomb on Easter Sunday was filled with hope for the world. The empty tomb became a resurrection miracle. When we feel isolated and alone, our emptiness leaves plenty of room for Jesus to enter.

I struggle with all the "extra images" of the Church Holy days. I feel like a party-pooper when the image of God is taken from front and center stage and moved to the back or God's story is removed completely, making lights/tinsel/wrapping paper/artificial grass/baskets/elf and rabbit/poinsettia and lily/and EASTER EGGS the primary focus point of us getting something of value on the day. The significance of a Holy Day can be lost to the value of the gift.

To offset this idea of "getting" at Christmas, I have used someone else's idea of putting an envelope in the Christmas tree with a note telling the recipient that something was done in their name at Christmas – feeding a hungry family, fitting a child with a winter hat/mittens/coat, paying an energy bill. What could we do to recall the gift of Easter?

It might be a good idea to intentionally give your guests one empty Easter egg with time taken to discuss how the empty egg is the sign of an empty tomb, and the empty tomb is filled with hope, promise, and the sign of The Resurrection, "He is not here." Spend some of your time sharing thoughts of a time you have been disappointed, rejected, alone. Recall the way someone came and shared your disappointment and gave you the gift of their time, energy, support.

It is easy for us to celebrate and proclaim our God as present when we are filled, happy, and content on the receiving end of the Holy Days. It is much harder to celebrate and proclaim our God when we are feeling alone, hungry, cold, or disappointed.

We all have friends and family who are dealing with disappointment, with loss, with separation, with rejection, and even with death. Do these people really need some jelly beans or a chocolate rabbit?

Join me in filling your Easter guests with love, support, encouragement, and the love of Emmanuel – God with us – Jesus. The "Bread of Life" will fill and sustain us through difficult times and will empower us to being people who are less concerned about what we got at Easter to remembering what God says to us every day, "I love you so much, give me your disappointments and let me fill them."
