Confession and Forgiveness

P: There is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.

C: Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

P: We do not do what we want, but the very thing we hate.

C: Yet Christ meets us in our failure and calls us again.

P: Let us reflect on where we have struggled with sin, where we have failed to love Christ, and where we need His restoring grace.

P: Let's pray together,

C: Lord Jesus, we confess that we do not do the good we want, but the very thing we hate. Sin dwells within us, and we feel the weight of our failure. We have denied you in our words, our actions, and our silence.

We have failed to love you with our whole heart, and have turned away from the calling you have given us. We are weary of our struggle and ashamed of our sin. Have mercy on us. Restore us again by your grace. Speak your forgiveness into our failure, and call us once more to follow you.

Reading 1

Romans 7:15-8:1

15 For I do not understand my own actions. For I do not do what I want, but I do the very thing I hate. 16 Now if I do what I do not want, I agree with the law, that it is good. 17 So now it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells within me. 18 For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh. For I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to carry it out. 19 For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I keep on doing. 20 Now if I do what I do not want, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells within me.

21 So I find it to be a law that when I want to do right, evil lies close at hand. 22 For I delight in the law of God, in my inner being, 23 but I see in my members another law waging war against the law of my mind and making me captive to the law of sin that dwells in my members. 24 Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? 25 Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself serve the law of God with my mind, but with my flesh I serve the law of sin.
