P: Blessed is the one whose delight is in the Word of the Lord.

P: All Scripture is God-breathed and useful for teaching and training in righteousness.

C: Yet we confess that we do not always remain in His Word.

P: Let us reflect on where we have neglected God's Word, where we have followed our own way, and where we have not been shaped by His truth.
