### Confession and Forgiveness

P: Throughout Scripture, we are told to remember what God has done.

C: So that when children ask, we will remember what the Lord has done.

P: And yet we're slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken.

C: So Christ meets us and opens the Scriptures to us.

P: Take a moment to consider God's goodness, and where we have been slow to believe, and where our hearts have grown cold to His promises.

(silence for reflection)

P: Let's pray together,

C: Gracious God, we confess that we are forgetful people. You have been faithful to us, yet we do not always remember your goodness. You have carried us through trials, provided for our needs, and kept your promises— yet we quickly forget and turn to fear and doubt. We are slow of heart to believe, and we fail to trust what you have spoken. Forgive us for forgetting or ignoring what you've done for us. Teach us to remember your works. Open our eyes to see your faithfulness, and rekindle our hearts through your Word. Teach us to trust in you, and to live in the confidence of your grace.

P: Brother and sisters, the Lord is faithful, even when we forget. The same Christ who walked with the disciples opens the Scriptures to you and makes Himself known. Your sins are forgiven. Your hearts are rekindled, and your eyes are opened. Remember His works, trust His promises, and live in the joy of His presence.

## Reading 1

### Joshua 4:1-9

4 When all the nation had finished passing over the Jordan, the Lord said to Joshua, 2 "Take twelve men from the people, from each tribe a man, 3 and command them, saying, 'Take twelve stones from here out of the midst of the Jordan, from the very place where the priests' feet stood firmly, and bring them over with you and lay them down in the place where you lodge tonight.'" 4 Then Joshua called the twelve men from the people of Israel, whom he had appointed, a man from each tribe. 5 And Joshua said to them, "Pass on before the ark of the Lord your God into the midst of the Jordan, and take up each of you a stone upon his shoulder, according to the number of the tribes of the people of Israel, 6 that this may be a sign among you. When your children ask in time to come, 'What do those stones mean to you?' 7 then you shall tell them that the waters of the Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the Lord. When it passed over the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. So these stones shall be to the people of Israel a memorial forever."

8 And the people of Israel did just as Joshua commanded and took up twelve stones out of the midst of the Jordan, according to the number of the tribes of the people of Israel, just as the Lord told Joshua. And they carried them over with them to the place where they lodged and laid them down there. 9 And Joshua set up twelve stones in the midst of the Jordan, in the place where the feet of the priests bearing the ark of the covenant had stood; and they are there to this day.

### **Luke 24:25-35**

25 And he said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken! 26 Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?" 27 And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself.

28 So they drew near to the village to which they were going. He acted as if he were going farther, 29 but they urged him strongly, saying, "Stay with us, for it is toward evening and the day is now far spent." So he went in to stay with them. 30 When he was at table with them, he took the bread and blessed and broke it and gave it to them. 31 And their eyes were opened, and they recognized him. And he vanished from their sight. 32 They said to each other, "Did not our hearts burn within us while he talked to us on the road, while he opened to us the Scriptures?" 33 And they rose that same hour and returned to Jerusalem. And they found the eleven and those who were with them gathered together, 34 saying, "The Lord has risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!" 35 Then they told what had happened on the road, and how he was known to them in the breaking of the bread.
